Description:

Over the recent years, the increased demand on the international cooperation in the area of police education, exchange of experience and development of vocational training courses have been observed. The project titled „Together against crime by education”, implemented by the leading forensic laboratories and Police academies from Czech Republic, Poland and Slovakia, took actions that would provide for the fulfillment of the above mentioned needs. The main objective of the project assumed the creation of two brand new curricula (courses) within the framework of vocational training for police officers that would be adapted to the police education system in the countries participating in the project. The first course was dedicated to the crime scene officers and the latter to the forensic experts. The curricula were developed based on the profile of crime scene officer and forensic expert, describing the scope of the knowledge and experience that the graduates of the respective courses shall gain. In order to verify and ensure the correctness and completeness of the content of the established curricula, 7 pilot courses were held within the framework of the project (4 courses for crime scene officers and 3 for forensic experts). The pilot courses were evaluated by the participants as well as by individuals from the project team, appointed to supervise the correct implementation of the new curricula. To ensure the sustainability of project results, the developed curricula will be introduced to the basic and complementary vocational trainings dedicated to the police officers in the police academies in the countries involved in the project. Additionally, the results of the project will be disseminated in the form of dedicated brochure and video material.
